History of the Estate

Château Petit Clos Du Roy is a beautiful Girondine Charter House with porch balusters from the eighteenth century. Located at the intersection of 4 cities: Saint Emilion, Pomerol, Neac and Montagne. One of the best 'terroirs' of Montagne Saint Emilion, located half a mile from the biggest Pomerol growths. The Janoeuix family has overseen the estate and the production of the wines here for three generations.

Winemaking and Vinification

14 hectares of strong and deep clay soil.

The viticulture and winemaking are strictly controlled, allowing the Chateau to offer wines corresponding to the tastes of wine lovers while remaining true to the character of the appellation. This has afforded the Chateau great success, even in years of drought.

Tasting Notes & Food Pairing

Elegant nose with a mixture of black currant, cherry, vanilla, tobacco, and pepper. Soft tannins lead the way to a beautiful after taste.
