History of the Estate

Château de BERTINEAU is located in the heart of the Néac plateau, surrounded by prestigious vineyards of Pomerol. The estate boasts an 18th century tower from where you can enjoy the best sightseeing view of Saint Emilion's vineyards and village. Château De Bertineau offers the perfect balance between tradition and modernity.

Winemaking and Vinification

15 hectares of clay and gravels on the Right Bank of the Garonne & Dordogne Rivers. Average age of the vines is 35 years old.

Stainless steel vats were made according to the different plot sizes. After fermentation and maceration steps, the wine is transferred into new French oak barrels in the barrel cellar, which hosts a capacity of 180 barrels. Ageing for 15 months in barrels.

Tasting Notes & Food Pairing

Château de Bertineau expresses the true character of the Lalande de Pomerol appellation. Aged in oak barrels, the younger brother of Pomerol is pure, floral, generous, and full-bodied. Black currant and blackberry fruit flavors lead to a long smooth finish with hints of oak spice and chocolate. Château Bertineau wine is powerful, fine round and fleshy. It is a perfect match for roast lamb and red meat in general.
